THE OAXACA LENDING LIBRARY, A.C. Activity Report Mexico City, October 13, 2025

The nonprofit organization THE OAXACA LENDING LIBRARY, A.C. (OLL), registered in the State of Oaxaca since the year 2000, is a bilingual lending library that carries out cultural, educational, and social activities intended for the general public and residents of Oaxaca in fulfillment of its social objectives. These activities include the promotion and dissemination of music, visual arts, dramatic arts, dance, literature, architecture, and cinematography through talks, author presentations, educational and cultural tours and hikes, language programs for adults and children, community partnerships, and maintenance of a bilingual collection of 31,910 books for adults, youth, and children. Children, youth, and students receive free OLL subscription memberships to borrow books. All activities are designed to promote a love of reading and learning that spans generations and cultures.

The OLL's bilingual programs and activities are held at its principal office located at José María Pino Suárez, No. 519, Ruta Independencia, Centro, 68000 Oaxaca de Juárez, Oaxaca, and throughout the State of Oaxaca and other regions in Mexico. Mainly run by a group of 140 dedicated volunteers, with forty members of various committees, the OLL has only three paid staff members: Library Manager, Circulation Desk Manager, and Administrative Assistant. https://www.oaxlibrary.org/who-is-the-oll

1. Language Exchanges (Intercambios) (Free)

2. Jóvenes Adelante (Youth Moving Forward)(Free)

- Nature of the activity: Cultural program that teaches intermediate English to youth and teens, including grammar, writing, and reading. The OLL youth library has 1,519 Spanish-language books and 2,267 English-language books, along with 495 Spanish-language teen books and 694 English-language teen books. All of these books can be borrowed.

3. ¡Niños Adelante! (Children Moving Forward)(Free)

- Nature of the activity: Cultural program that teaches English to children through songs, games, and reading. The OLL is a member of the Libros para Pueblos, A.C. (LpP) network of approximately 60 libraries. LpP establishes long-term relationships with libraries in economically and socially disadvantaged regions of Oaxaca to foster effective early intervention in reading promotion. The OLL children's library has 1,396 Spanish-language books, and 1,780 English- language books that can be borrowed.
- **Schedule:** Saturdays from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in person.

7. Terrace Talks

- Nature of the activity: As part of its cultural programming, the OLL offers a series of diverse educational and cultural "Terrace Talks." The topics of the Talks range from matters of local interest, like water and gentrification, to Oaxacan history, culture, and languages, to transnational issues like migration and climate change. Many talks are about the visual arts, music, dance, photography, cinematography, architecture, and design. All Terrace Talks are delivered by knowledgeable and accomplished presenters, well-versed in their subject matter. In 2023, the OLL presented 54 talks attended by 1,946 persons; in 2024, the OLL presented 60 talks attended by 2,188 persons; and to date in 2025 the OLL has presented 39 talks attended by 1,298 persons.

 community partners, artists and artisans, families, and community elders to provide
 a rich, educational, and memorable experience for participants.

10. Hikes - Hoofing it in Oaxaca

 Nature of the activity: Cultural activities consisting of educational and cultural hikes led by a bilingual expert guide who shares extensive knowledge of the physical and cultural aspects of the region. Includes a variety of day and overnight hikes in the Oaxaca Valley and surrounding mountains.

- **Schedule:** Offered several times a week, primarily from November to March.
- Location: Central valleys and mountains of Oaxaca. Meeting point: Calle de Los Libres, between Zarate and San Martín, behind the Grand Fiesta Americana Hotel. Most hikes depart at 8:00 a.m.
- **Audience:** General public (59 hikes recorded in 2023 with 939 participants, 73 in 2024 with 871 participants, and 48 so far in 2025 with 670 participants).

Since almost sixty years ago when a group of friends began to pool resources to share a bequest of 300 books with the Oaxacan community, the OLL has evolved into a vibrant not-for-profit bilingual lending library and cultural and educational center that fosters solidarity and appreciation, while promoting community empowerment.
