APPROVAL OF SEPTEMBER MINUTES

John Dumser moved to accept the minutes. John Hunter seconded. All in favor. None opposed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- Día de Muertos: Altar, talks and tours. The altar will go up on the 27th. The memorial talk will take place on the 29th.
- The bazaar will be held on Dec. 14
- Elections Nominating Committee chair has had chats with potential new candidates but has not met with them. They are looking at 2-4 nominees
- The resident African Americans and OLL meeting is scheduled for mid-November
- Updated handouts on Intercambios and Niños/Jóvenes Adelante: John H and John D made a few adjustments.
- The city ordered terrace inspections of our terrace. Obligations have been met. Waiting on final approval from the municipality

TREASURER'S REPORT

- OLL can give donations to other associations with receipt of a Donataria Recibo.
- Request made to include year-to-date numbers along with a rolling budget in the monthly treasurer's report. John will produce a line chart.
- John D. reported on budget numbers for last month. Cash on hand was 19,700 + 57,000 = total 113,000 MXN, slowly coming down from prior months. We are hoping for a strong fourth quarter.
- We received a \$1,000 USD contribution last month.
- Year-to-date (YTD) expenses: -280,000 MXN, with three months remaining to cover.
- John reported that the annual limit on OLLF transfers as an A.C. is 180,000 MXN.
- Current total transfers stand at 168,000 MXN.

- We are required to file a report with SAT covering all transfers.
- Last year we had a strong December with a large profit, including some January sales
- The end of December marks the close of our fiscal year; the library operates on a cash basis.

<u>Update from 60th Anniversary Fundraising Subcommittee</u>:

(Jeff Stewart and Carol Ringold) Jeff Stewart:

- Our campaign runs through mid-March; dissolving Mar 31.
- This will be our biggest fundraise. Our covid era campaign raised \$50 grand.
- The library currently receives between \$2,000 \$3,000 usd per year in donations.
- Donate if you can, and ask your friends.
- Terrace talk: Dave Myler will talk about the history of OLL. There will be pitches at the Christmas dinner with fresh material.
- We'll have another talk by David Myler in January. Perhaps honoring past OLL presidents Today we're at \$7,000 usd so we've raised 10% already!
- Donations can be made online from a link in Facebook that will be made available.
- Direct donations to the library in pesos avoid the transfers from OLLF.

<u>Update from 60th Anniversary Celebration Task Force:</u>

(John Dumser and John Hunter)

- Five teams are working on organizing events and bringing other people in. Health, music, LGBTQ, kickoff, and African Americans.
- Celebration runs from Jan 1 to Dec 31, 2026. We'll cover every month with one augmenting event.
- Our main objective is outreach to the Mexican community. Focus: Facing Toward the Future.
- Presentations in English and Spanish. Kickoff: Friday Jan 9 & Sat 10.
- José Luis will organize a student based calenda inviting schools, using costumes with book characters, posters with book quotes, puppets, music & readings in the street. We want to bring in people who currently don't have a connection to OLL
- We are working on a calenda description and a children's band.

OLL and Libros Para Pueblos

• OLL will need to have a social service volunteer in January to maintain compliance with LPP protocols.

- OLL will look for a university student. Minimum required hours are: 3x per week, 2 hours per visit, with a 500-hour commitment.
- The LPP annual conference is February 28,

Priority items from website to be translated to Spanish now? (John Dumser)

- We're focusing on Facebook for now.
- Facebook and friends of OLL reach almost 4,000 people. Ninos & Jovenes will need more publication. Doug would like a digital poster for the website. John D and Adriana will follow up.
- We want to update the OLL website to include 2 versions: one in English one in Spanish.
- A motion was made to have a website subcommittee including Doug, Marc, John, and Viviana, reporting to the board in February. John D seconded. All in favor. None Opposed.

Spanish name of OLL: Biblioteca de Préstamo de Oaxaca?

Motion to approve by Bonny Weil, seconded by John Hunter. Discussion: Viviana objects that the name is obvious. Each library has their own lending policy. Specialty libraries don't lend out. A more sensible name would be: Biblioteca OLL. Motion amended to approve Biblioteca OLL by Viviana Ruiz Boijseauneau, John Hunter seconded, all in favor, none opposed.
